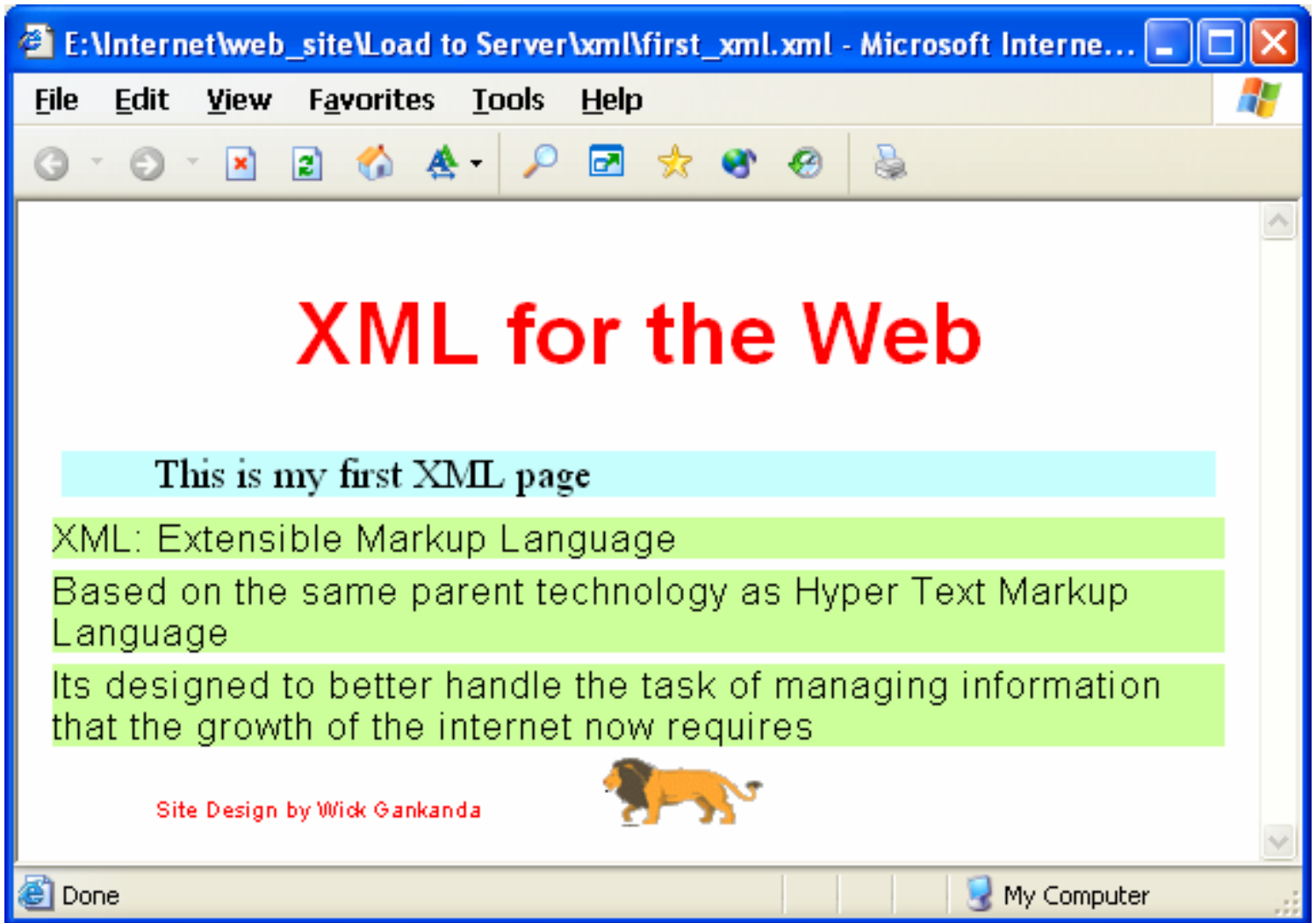


My first XML Page
